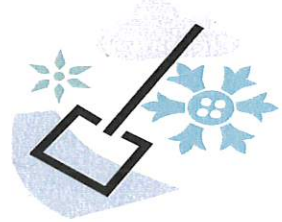

## TAX COLLECTION AND DOG LICENSES

### Election Update

Tim Gould will not be seeking re-election this spring. Mr. Gould has been on the Village Board and we will certainly miss his input.

### Building Permits

The building permits fee for both residential and commercial structures will be increasing starting January 1st as follows:

General/Residential: \$30.00

New Home: \$100.00

Additions– Residential/Commercial: \$100.00

New Commercial: \$150.00

Tax collections this year will again be done by the Marinette County treasurer. Please make sure all payments are made to them, and **NOT** to the Village of Coleman.

Dog licenses, however, need to be obtained annually from the Village clerk at the Coleman Municipal Building.

It is unlawful for any person in the Village of Coleman to own, harbor, or keep any dog more than five(5) months of age without obtaining a license for said dog.

To obtain a dog license in the Village of Coleman, residents must apply at the Municipal Building. The cost for each license is \$10.00 for a male or female dog, and \$5.00 for a neutered male or spayed female dog. You will be required to provide a current vaccination form, which will include date of vaccination, vaccine manufacturer, serial # of vaccine, and expiration date. No license will be issued without the above mentioned information.

**Licenses need to be purchased by April 1st.** A \$5.00 late fee will be added to those who apply after April 1st.

Any person owning or having control of any dog, cat, or other animal shall clean up the feces of such animal immediately and dispose of it in a sanitary manner. (May we suggest when you walk your pet that you carry a plastic bag with you to pick up any droppings.) No animal feces shall be permitted to remain exposed upon any private or public property. Failure to comply with this ordinance will result in a fine for each incident cited.



### House and Building Numbers

Please ensure that your house/building number is clearly showing on your home/building. The number should be shown on the side of your building facing the street which is your street address for mailing.

If you live near a fire hydrant and are able to, please clear snow out from around the fire hydrant. This would be a great help to our fire department in case of an emergency. Thank you!



*Thank you to everyone lighting up the Village for the holidays including those businesses who lit up the trees in the park and near the gazebo! Decorations on the trees in the park can be removed anytime after Jan 1st.*



### **NOTICE OF PARKING BAN**

No vehicles shall be parked on any street in the Village of Coleman, between the hours of 2 am and 6 am from November 15th through April 1st. This restriction is necessary to accommodate snow plowing and snow removal equipment. Failure to comply will result in a \$5.00 fine. If not paid within 5 days, the fine doubles and an additional citation can be issued.

### **Garbage/Recycling Pick Up During Winter Months**

- ◆ Keep your garbage and recycle bins off embankments of snow during the winter months.
- ◆ Do not block the drive-up to your mailbox with your bins or your mail may not be delivered that day.
- ◆ Bins may not be placed on the road as this prevents proper plowing.
- ◆ Ensure bins are closed properly preventing snow and ice from entering your bin.
- ◆ Ensure there is a few feet of space between each bin so the arm of the truck can grasp the can
- ◆ Boxes must be broken down to be recycled and should fit in your bin with the lid closed.

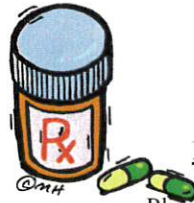
*The ice rink will be opening soon! It is located on the west side of Faith Christian School near the small park area behind Family Dollar.*



### Making Online Payments

Online payments have been accepted at the Village of Coleman for some time now. Some things to remember:

- ◆ There is a fee for using your card and paying online. It is figured on a sliding scale based on the amount you are paying.
- ◆ As with any monetary transaction, please allow around three business days for transactions to process fully.
- ◆ It is NOT necessary to contact the Municipal Building to pay online. You can use the internet or make a call to the service directly. (The fees by phone are slightly more than payments via internet.) Call 1-888-604-7888 to pay via phone. [www.allpaid.com](http://www.allpaid.com) can be used to pay online.



### Drug Drop Box Placed at Municipal Building

Please feel free to come and drop off any drugs that are no longer being used so that they may be disposed of in the proper manner. The Drug Box is located in the lobby of the Municipal Building as is available during regular office hours.

Accepted: Prescription Medication, Over the Counter Medication, Liquid Medication

Not Accepted: Illegal drugs, Needles/syringes or sharps containers, Medical devices, Batteries, Aerosol cans, Inhalers, Chemicals, Mercury-containing devices, Radiopharmaceuticals, Liquid antineoplastic agents

Illegal drugs should be handed to the police department rather than using the drug drop box. All medications should be left in their original packaging if possible.
