

Garbage/ Recycling Guidelines

Please ensure that your trash and recycling bins are placed at least 3 feet apart allowing GFL Environmental enough room to grab your bin properly with the arm of the disposal truck. It is often easiest to place your bins one on each side of your driveway. Additionally, our regular driver (not our fill in drivers) will often place your bins where he would like you to place them for him. Take a look at the placement of your bin after a pick up.
