COMMUNITY RUMMAGE SALES

Friday, May 10th & Saturday, May 11th 2024

The Village of Coleman will host the Community Rummage Sales again this year. An ad will be posted in the paper for the dates of the sale. What is the Public Fire Protection Charge?

This charge is required by State law and regulated by the State of Wisconsin's Public Service Commission. It recovers the cost of water for fighting fires and the extra capacity built into the system to rapidly deliver a large volume of water to fight a fire anywhere within the Water Utility's service area. These costs include a portion of wells, pumps, storage facilities, water mains, hydrants, and an estimated quantity of water used for this purpose.

Waste Water Treatment Plant

Our current WWTP was built in 1981 with a 20-year design capacity that has been exceeded by an additional 23 years due in large part to the conscientious efforts of our DNR certified Wastewater Operators. However, due to the strict mandates of the State, the Village must make upgrades to the existing plant with an estimated cost of \$3.5 million. We did receive a grant to help with some of the cost. Construction is scheduled to begin this fall.

Participants will be required to sign a registration form at the site indicating their name and address. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated. You will be responsible for unloading your own truck or trailer (with the possible assistance of a village worker) into the dumpsters. There will be a 2-yd limit per household (approx. a pick-up load) . . . **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**

Items accepted: Furniture, mattresses, scrap building material, metal items, and other bulky trash that is not acceptable for regular garbage pick-up. Paint cans will be accepted, but must have lids off and be either completely empty or completely dried up. No lead based paints will be accepted. The Village will collect waste oil, but will no longer provide a collection barrel. You must leave your waste oil in a container which will not be returned. Car batteries will now be accepted. **Tires are not accepted. Electronics will be accepted for a fee which will be based upon their size.**

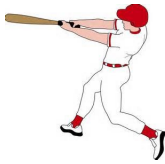
Appliances: Only non-freon appliances (e.g. stoves, washers, dryers) will be accepted at a cost based on size. Payment must be made for each item at the time of disposal. If paying with cash, please have the exact amount due; if paying by check, payment for the correct amount should be made out to "Village of Coleman". The Village will not accept appliances containing Freon (e.g. refrigerators, dehumidifiers, air conditioners).

Items not accepted: Hazardous waste such as household or garden chemicals, bio-medical waste, batteries other than car batteries, recyclable items, lead based paints, tires, and automotive fluids other than oil. No demolition materials will be accepted.

Yard and garden waste can be dropped off in the usual place.

Just a reminder that there is to be no open burning of leaves in the Village. Please use the recycle center to dispose of your yard waste.



The recycle center will again be open starting March 9th & 23rd, April 13th & 27th, May 4th & 18th and June 8th & 22nd from 9:00 am - 1:00 pm. The Village will still be offering spring and fall clean up dates where many bulk items can be brought to the dumpster free of charge. There is NO roadside pick up for items not fitting in your bins. As always, GFL does not pick up loose bags. All garbage and recycling must be in your bin. Please ensure that all items are in your bin with the lid closed.

Please remember to keep your dog on a leash or fenced in. Pick up all feces immediately, and register your dog annually at the Municipal Building. After April 1st there is a \$5.00 late fee per animal.
