Please remember to keep your dogs and cats on a leash or fenced in. **No animals are allowed on the ball fields.** No animals are to be at large in the Village. Village residents are only permitted an aggregate of 3 dogs/cats. Pick up all feces immediately, and register your dog annually. Per state statute, all dogs need to be licensed or a fine could be imposed. Stop by the Municipal Building for a license if you have not done so already. Those violating the Village ordinances may be cited. Animals at large will be taken to a shelter to be cared for at the expense of the owner.

### Watch Your Lawn!

Did you know that the Village has an ordinance affecting your lawn? Ordinance #162-10 states no person owning property within the Village of Coleman shall permit to grow or pollinate upon his premises any weeds or grasses which cause or produce hay fever in human beings, exhale unpleasant or noxious odors, or conceal filthy deposits. In order to prevent such growth or pollination, it shall be the duty of every property owner to mow or cause to be mowed upon his premises all grasses or weeds

### **Garbage/ Recycling Guidelines**

Please ensure that your trash and recycling bins are placed at least 3 feet apart allowing GFL Environmental enough room to grab your bin properly with the arm of the disposal truck. It is often easiest to place your bins one on each side of your driveway. Additionally, our regular driver (not our fill in drivers) will often place your bins where he would like you to place them for him. Take a look at the placement of your bin after a pickup. It may give you an idea of how our driver would like your bins placed. If you have questions, please contact the Municipal Building. Per ordinance after pickup please roll your bins by your house or garage.
