

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 290-4 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF COLEMAN, WISCONSIN GOVERNING VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF COLEMAN, MARINETTE COUNTY, WISCONSIN DOES HEREBY ORDAIN THAT CHAPTER 290-4 BE AMENDED TO ADD SECTION 12:

**§ 290-4. Stopping or parking prohibited in certain specified places.**

A. No person shall stop, park or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended and whether temporarily or otherwise, in any of the following places:

(1) Within an intersection.

(2) On a crosswalk.

(3) On a sidewalk or sidewalk area, except when parking in such place is clearly indicated by official traffic signs or markers or parking meters.

(4) Alongside or opposite any highway excavation or obstruction when such stopping or standing would obstruct traffic or when pedestrian traffic would be required to travel in the roadway.

(5) On the roadway side of any parked vehicle unless double parking is clearly indicated by official traffic signs or markers.

(6) Within 20 feet of the driveway entrance to a fire station.

(7) Upon any portion of a highway where and at the time when stopping or standing is prohibited by official traffic signs indicating the prohibition of any stopping or standing.

(8) In any place or manner so as to obstruct or hinder traffic.

(9) Within 10 feet of a fire hydrant, unless a greater distance is indicated by an official traffic sign.


(10) Upon any portion of a highway where and at the time when parking is prohibited, limited or restricted by official traffic signs.


(11) Upon any bridge.

(12) Parking of trailers detached from motor vehicles is prohibited on all Village streets and public areas. This subsection shall not apply to stopping or standing for the purposes of, and while actually engaged in, loading or unloading or in receiving or discharging passengers while the motor vehicle remains operator-attended as necessary to move in case of an emergency or to avoid obstructing traffic or while engaged in business activity. "Trailer," "stopping," "parking," "standing," or any synonymous term shall have such meaning as prescribed under Ch. 340, Wisconsin State Statutes where and as necessary to give effect to the purpose of this section.
