CAUTIONARY STATEMENT TO OWNERS OBTAINING BUILDING PERMITS:

Please read and sign at bottom.

Wisconsin Statutes requires municipalities that enforce the Uniform Dwelling Code to provide an owner who applies for a building permit with a statement advising the owner that:

No person or entity may engage or offer to engage in construction business in Wisconsin unless they hold a Building Contractor Registration, or equivalent, issued by the Safety and Building Division of the Wisconsin Department of Commerce.

Wisconsin Administrative code CH.NR447 pertains to asbestos that may be encountered during building renovations and remodeling.

In addition to required smoke alarms, any residence with a gas fired appliance is required to have a carbon monoxide detector on each floor level.

Please be advised of regulations that cover lead hazards that can exist in housing and child occupied facilities built before 1978. When work disturbs paint on the interior, or exterior, involves window replacement or partial demolition. Regulated renovation projects require a DHS-Certified Lead-Safe Contractor.
